Petitioner claims that he had made a compliant dated 30.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, on which the police is refusing to register a case, stating that no cognizance offence is made out. The prayer is for directing the police to register the case.

I am of the view that if the police after investigation found that no cognizance offence is made out, the petitioner is always at liberty to file a criminal complaint before the learned Illaqa Magistrate with appropriate prayers and it is for the Magistrate to take a decision in the matter.
