The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 83 dated 05.05.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 379, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No. 7, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he has raised lalkara only and no injury is attributed to him. He further states that the petitioner is 70 years old and ready to join the investigation.

This Court, vide order dated 23.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Madan Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 23.08.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 23.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
