The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.83 dated 05.05.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 379, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation and therefore, the petitioner should be granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Heard.

A perusal of the MLR of the complainant indicates that he has received 19 injuries. The petitioner is stated to have caused two injuries with *kirpan* on the left wrist of the complainant and one of those injuries has been declared as a grievous in nature.

Therefore, I do not find it to be a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the instant petition stands dismissed.
