The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.51 dated 08.05.2017, registered under Sections 365 and 341 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Goindwal Sahib, Distt. Tarn Taran.

Heard.

On 23.08.2017, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. The son of the complainant, namely, Manpreet Singh solemnized marriage with Gurpreet Kaur who is daughter of the main accused i.e. Rajpal Singh. It is alleged that both had been taken away by the accused including the petitioner. Further the petitioner has no connectivity with the families of either the complainant or the co-accused. The alleged abductees have joined their respective families.

Notice of motion for 19.09.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner

by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

3.That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.08.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
