FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Allegations against the petitioner Amritpal Singh Sekhon in this second regular bail application filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.330 dated 19.09.2016 registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur under Sections 323/324/341/506/427/120-B/148/ 149/201/308 IPC, are that on 17.09.2016 petitioner along with his co-accused have assailed complainant Prabhjot Singh.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner is behind bars for the last more than one year and the parties have effected compromise.

Though learned State counsel has sought to oppose grant of relief to the petitioner but could not refute the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner and even learned counsel representing the

complainant Mr. Harpal Preet Singh Chopra, Advocate has placed on record compromise (Annexure P2).

Appreciating the submissions of the two sides, keeping in view that similarly placed co-accused Jagwant Singh alias Bunti and Hardeep Singh alias Deep have been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 29.03.2017, and that the parties have effected compromise and thus, to put an end to this feud, impels this Court to allow the prayer. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
