The present petition has been filed under Section 439 the Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in case FIR No.117 dated 17.08.2015, registered under Sections 21, 25 and 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 17.08.2015 and charges have been framed but none of the prosecution witness has been examined so far.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

As per the FIR, one kilogram of heroin was recovered

from the possession of the petitioner. The quantity is commercial in

nature. Further, a perusal of file shows that co-accused Harbhagwant Singh @ Harji approached this Court by filing CRM M-9692 of 2016 for grant of regular bail. The said bail application was dismissed. However, a direction was given to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within five months from the date of passing of the order.

In view of above, no case for grant of concession of bail is made out.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
