HARI PAL VERMA, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 29.9.2017, petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted to bail by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phagwara vide order dated 27.10.2017. The order dated 29.9.2017, passed by this Court reads as under: -

“This Court vide order dated 29.09.2016 had granted time to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and the order dated 17.07.2012 whereby the petitioner was declared proclaimed person, was stayed. But still, the petitioner has not surrendered before the trial Court.

Now after about a year, learned counsel for the petitioner has made another request with an undertaking that the petitioner will appear before the trial Court within a period of one month from today.

Though there is no justification to give any further opportunity to the petitioner, however, in the interest of justice, one more opportunity is granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of one month from today. In case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the trial Court within stipulated period, the present petition would be deemed to be dismissed. Further, if the petitioner comes back to India within one month from today, he shall not be arrested from the Airport.

Adjourned to 27.11.2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, submits that petitioner is required for further investigation and therefore State be given liberty to approach the trial Court to have necessary direction from the concerned Court.

Be that as it may, considering the fact that petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court, present petition no more survives and accordingly the same is disposed of as infructuous.

Disposed of as such.
