Petitioner, in this second petition, seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.187 dated 01.11.2012, under Sections 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station C-Division, District Amritsar City, Amritsar.

Relevant portion of order dated 03.06.2017 passed by learned trial Court is reproduced below:-

“6. Admittedly, as per judicial record, the applicant was already declared proclaimed offender on 01.04.2014. Thereafter, again on being released on bail, he misused the said liberty and infringed the conditions of bail by not appearing in the Court and he was again declared PO on 21.7.2015. In these circumstances, there is likelihood that the applicant who has misused the liberty of bail is not entitled to the discretionary relief of bail. Hence, the bail stands dismissed.”

Perusal of above order shows that the petitioner was granted several chances to be at liberty, during trial. However, on two occasions, he misused the liberty and accordingly, trial Court has dismissed his application for grant of regular bail.

In that view of the matter, this petition is dismissed. Trial Court is directed to complete the trial within a period of 2 months from today as the petitioner is in jail.
