Petitioners-Raj Kumar @ Raja, Ram Kumar, Sandeep and Dharambir have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.228 dated 04.06.2017, registered at Police Station Barwala, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 324, 341, 326, 427 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

Complainant has also appeared through her counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that first of all, the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class and the petitioners have been in custody since 12.07.2017. Moreover, compromise has taken place between the parties and it is a case of version and cross-version.

Now, the petitioners are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
