[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioners have prayed for quashing of FIR No.51, dated 25.04.2015, under Sections 323, 382, 353, 332, 186 & 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Bhikiwind, District Tarn Taran on the grounds stated therein.

[4]. After hearing both sides, this Court is of the opinion that no grounds to quash the pending proceedings are made out on merits.

[5]. It is, however, submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioners that charges in the Trial Court have already been framed. In the circumstances, he restricts his prayer to the extent that only petitioner No.1, who stated to be an old lady of 68 years may be permitted to be exempted from personal appearance in the Trial Court henceforth subject to the undertaking that no adjournment on account of her absence shall be sought for and her

identification during the trial will also not be challenged.

[6]. Ordered accordingly with a rider that petitioner No.1 shall, however, be obligated to appear before the Trial Court at the stage of examination under Section 313 Cr.P.C. and also at the time of pronouncement of the final Judgment.
