Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.144 dated 28.06.2017 registered under Sections 279, 337, 338, 201 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, on the basis of compromise Annexure-P2.

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 23.08.2017 passed by this Court, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya on 05.09.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide letter bearing No.727 dated 12.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur vide letter bearing No.18977 dated 12.09.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya, the compromise between the parties appears to be genuine, voluntary, without any pressure or coercion, fear or threat and with their own free will.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.144, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
