The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.424 dated 11th June, 2017, registered under Sections 3/13(1), 8/13(3) and 17 of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh, Haryana.

It transpires from that investigation in this case has already been completed and even charges have been framed against two persons including the present petitioner in the Ld. Trial Court.

In the circumstances, the petitioner may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court with a further condition to

report at the local Police Station once a week till such time as thought fit and proper, which is left to the discretion of the Ld. Trial Court.
