SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.222, dated 4th April, 2017, registered under Sections 307, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') and Sections 25-54-59 of the Arms Act and later on Section 114, 201, 386 IPC was added at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

The petitioner was arrested on 3rd of May, 2017. Challan against him has already been submitted under Sections 307, 506, 120-B, 386, 144 of the IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act. Admittedly, he was not named in the FIR and no actual injury to the complainant took place. The incriminating material against the

petitioner has come-forth only through the statement of the co-accused persons.

In such circumstances, this does not appear to be a fit case to keep him in detention for an indefinite period. He may, therefore, be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court, Palwal.
