FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

In compliance of order dated 12.10.2017 as has been brought to the notice of this Court by the learned Senior counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner and his Companies Hind Motors Ltd. and Hind Motors India Ltd. on behalf of their Managers including the present petitioner have entered into an agreement with 161 claimants who have claimed that their dues outstanding against the management and have placed on record photostat copy of the modalities so settled with each other indicating schedule of the payment to which both the sides have readily agreed.

Mr. Cheema has made statement that as per the instructions received from the petitioner's side and the Management they are

ready to accommodate on the same terms and conditions, if any, remaining claimants come forward and they will be bound by that undertaking.

In view thereof and in the light of settlement having been arrived between the parties which is not disputed by the learned State counsel, in the interest of justice, the present petition stands allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
