The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 16 dated 04.08.2015 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 and 354-A IPC at Police Station Women Jagraon, District Ludhiana (R).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the father-in-law of the complainant. He has nothing to do with the matrimonial life of his son and the complainant.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation in pursuance of the order dated 09.11.2017.

A transcript of the CD has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record. The transcript indicates prima-facie that the allegations made are neither motivated nor ill-conceived. Therefore, no case for grant of concession of anticipatory bail is made out.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
