The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.482 dated 27.04.2017 registered under Sections 379-B read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that there is no other case against the petitioner. The matter has been examined by me in that context. Perused the evidence of the witnesses. All the witnesses have turned hostile to the prosecution.

Learned State counsel however, relied on the recover of the pistol on the spot by the complainant and others. Nevertheless, the fact remains that the witnesses have turned hostile, including the complainant.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-31081 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
