 Learned counsel for the petitioners who are the residents of the Society namely Skynet Enclave Residents Welfare Association (Regd.), Zirakpur have stated that respondents No. 7 and 8 have filed a civil suit and obtained the status quo order and thereafter carved out a path by mishandling the residents of the Skynet Enclave, Lohgarh Zirakpur, Punjab. Regarding the said incident, an FIR No. 309 dated 17.09.2016 has also been registered at Police Station, Zirakpur, District Mohali.

 As per the version of the learned State counsel, the matter has been investigated and the challan is ready and the police will present the same before the appropriate Court very soon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that some of the persons out of the respondents, who are responsible for the said attack, have not been challaned so far and that the residents of the petitioner’s society apprehend threat to their life and liberty.

I am of the view that if the residents of the petitioner’s society are not satisfied with the aforesaid investigation of the Police, they can always file a criminal complaint which can be tried along with the State case. However, if they got any instance of a specific threat from anybody, they can always move an appropriate application before the SHO Police Station, Zirakpur, who will enquire into the matter in accordance with law.

In view of the above noted observations, present petition stands disposed of.
