Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.73 dated 08.04.2017 under Sections 302/323/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar.

In the initial statement of complainant Deepika, the petitioner, armed with a *Dang*, had caused injuries to her brother deceased Abhishek alias Janu, whereas in her subsequent statement made on 10.04.2017, the complainant changed the role of the petitioner that he caused injuries to injured Shammi and not to deceased Abhishek alias Janu. According to her subsequent statement, the petitioner gave a *Dang* blow near elbow of right arm of Shammi, which according to learned counsel for the petitioner falls

Considering over all circumstances and the fact that the injury allegedly caused by the petitioner did not result in the death of deceased Abhishek alias Janu, this Court finds it a fit case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to her furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
