ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.21 dated 13.02.2017 under Sections 307/452/323/325/506/148/149 registered at Police Station Urban Estate, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are vague and he is alleged to have caused injuries on the non-vital parts of the body of injured Maninder Kaur with baseball bat. He further states that petitioner is 20 years old and is in custody for over six months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, states that charges have been framed in the case on 11.08.2017 and now the case is listed on 11.09.2017 for examination of prosecution witnesses which are 24 in number.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody for over six months ever since his arrest on 21.02.2017 and he is alleged to have caused injuries on the non-vital parts of the body of injured with baseball bat. He is 20 years old. The trial is likely to take some time to conclude.

In view of the aforementioned facts and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it fit to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Jaspal Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
