JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.92 dated 20.11.2015, registered under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Women, Amritsar City, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 11.09.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with regard to the veracity of the compromise arrived at between the parties. As per report dated 04.10.2017, from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, the parties did not appear before the Court for recording statements. Earlier also, two opportunities were availed by the parties. It appears that the parties have lost interest in the matter.

Even today, a written request for adjournment has been

circulated on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioners, however, in view of the report received, no case for deferment is made out.

Consequently, the instant petition is dismissed at this stage.
