By these petitions, quashing of FIR No.223 dated 27.12.2012, registered against the petitioners at Police Station, Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/324/34 and Section 326 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, and quashing of Criminal Complaint No.2 dated 11.01.2013, registered under Sections 323/452/148/149 of IPC, titled as “Charanjit Kaur Vs. Sher Singh and others”, is sought, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners-accused and respondent No.2-Sher Singh alias Shamsher Singh

(in CRM-M-3119 of 2017) and respondent no.1-Charanjit Kaur (in CRM-M-3702-2017(O&M)).

Vide orders of this Court dated February 01, 2017 and February 06, 2017, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid orders, separate reports in each case, of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur, have been received, in which it is stated that the statements of the petitioners in both these petitions, i.e. of Dalwinder Singh and Gurshankar Singh (petitioners in CRM-M-3119-2017) and of Sher Singh alias Shamsher Singh, Balkar Singh, Paramjeet Singh, Jaspreet Singh alias Gurjaap Singh and Lovepreet Singh (petitioners in CRM-M-3702-2017), were recorded on 06.02.2017 and 13.02.2017. The statements of the complainants in both the cases, i.e. of Sher Singh alias Shamsher Singh (respondent No.2 in CRM-M-3119-2017) and Charanjit Kaur (respondent No.1 in CRM-M-3702 of 2017), were also recorded on the aforesaid dates respectively.

As per the assessment of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur, the compromise arrived at between the parties in both the cases, appears to be genuine.

Keeping in view the fact that the cases relate to the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/324/34, and Section 326 in FIR No.223 dated 27.12.2012, and the alleged commission of offences under Sections 323/452/148/149 IPC in Criminal Complaint No.2 dated 11.01.2013, with the matters having been amicably settled between the

parties, it would be in the interest of peace to quash the criminal proceedings, in the opinion of this Court.

Accordingly, FIR No.223 dated 27.12.2012, registered against the petitioners in CRM-M-3119 of 2017 at Police Station, Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/324/34 and Section 326 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, and Criminal Complaint No.2 dated 11.01.2013, are hereby quashed, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
