Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.71 dated 06.02.2013 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Yamuna Nagar City, District Yamuna Nagar, on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 24.08.2017 passed by this Court, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, on 13.09.2017 and got recorded their statements qua compromise. Report from the concerned Judge has also been received vide letter bearing No.162 dated 22.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar vide letter bearing No.19697 dated 22.09.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, the parties have actually entered into a compromise by their free-will and the compromise is genuine.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.71, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
