INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Anmol Singh has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.174 dated 14.09.2014, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC and Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 and 177 of IPC, added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier, the petitioner was on bail. However, he absented from the court proceedings later on and was ultimately declared proclaimed offender.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner has himself surrendered before the trial Court and has been in custody since 20.09.2016.

The petitioner has been in custody for the last one year. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
