The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the representations dated 19.08.2017 and 21.08.2017 to be decided expeditiously.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner herein is facing harassment at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7 and on that account is now residing in Moga. She has already moved two representations seeking protection to respondents No.2 and 3, however, the same are pending consideration and no action has been taken thereon. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representations should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. M.S. Nagra Punjab,

accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representations of the petitioner within a period of three weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let four copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representations dated 19.08.2017 and 21.08.2017 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) of the petitioner within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and take the necessary action, if required.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
