ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.309 dated 16.08.2017, under Sections 153 and 153-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station, Civil Lines Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR do not, prima facie, constitute an offence under Sections 153 and 153-A of the IPC.

This Court by the order dated 25.08.2017 had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and he was to be released on ad interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, states that in terms of the previous order of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 25.08.2017 granting ad interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
