The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.4 dated 06.04.2016 registered under Sections 409, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13(1)(d) read with 13(2) Prevention of Corruption Act at Vigilance Bureau, FS-1 SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 29.08.2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rajneesh Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 29.08.2017 is made absolute, subject to surrender of passport by the petitioner with the police, if he possesses the same.
