[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

[3]. It transpires that the petitioner was granted interim bail by the Ld. Trial Court with a direction to join the investigation on 02.06.2017. He, however, failed to join the investigation on account of which his application for anticipatory bail was ordered to be dismissed.

[4]. It has been made out on behalf of the petitioner that he could not join the investigation due to serious illness of his mother at the relevant time, to support which contention, a copy of her medical prescription (Annexure P-2), has been filed.

subsequently on merits after considering the case record.
