Petitioner-Sarabjit Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.121 dated 30.09.2013, registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Ropar, under Sections 302 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, main allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner to the effect that murder has been committed at his instance.

As per learned State counsel, the present petitioner was dismissed from the service on the complaint of the deceased and that was the motive for the petitioner for committing the murder of the deceased by got mixing poisonous substance in his food.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of nature and gravity of the offence, however, without discussing the facts in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
