This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular interim bail to the petitioner for a period of two months in FIR No.390 dated 24.04.2017, under Sections 304-B, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Hisar.

By an order dated 15.09.2017, the petitioner herein was ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of eight weeks in order to donate his kidney to his ailing brother, with a direction to surrender before the trial court on completion of said eight weeks.

Today, this court is informed by counsel for the petitioner that in compliance of the order of this court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial court, after expiry of period of eight weeks, which fact is not

disputed by leaned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State.

In view of the above, the instant petition stands disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
