On asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior Deputy
Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

A copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Appeal filed by the petitioner against his conviction, was
pending in the Court of Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar. He
absented himself from the proceedings, on account of which, non-bailable
warrants were issued against him.

His contention before this Court is that he was unable to attend
the Court on account of being conflicted with Chicken-pox for a
considerable time. To support this contention, a copy of the Medical
Certificate issued by the Hospital (Annexure P-3) has also been filed.

As the returnable date in the Ld. Appellate Court is already
fixed for 21st of September, 2017, so this application is disposed off with a
direction that the petitioner shall not arrested, but he shall surrender before
the Ld. Appellate Court on or before the next date fixed, after which his
fresh application for bail may be considered on merits.
