ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.277 dated 01.10.2016 under Sections 323/341/342/356/365/307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he had fired a shot on the leg of complainant. He further states that it was an accidental fire and the matter has been compromised with the complainant. He further contends that complainant has fully recovered from the injury. It is further contended that petitioner is in custody for over 11 months since his arrest on 13.12.2016.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Satpal, states that charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined in the case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view that petitioner is in custody for almost 11 months and the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Rajender Singh @ Raju is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
