Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of necessary directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents and to restrain them from entering into the plot of the petitioner.

Admittedly, a civil dispute is pending between the parties and on account of violation of order passed on an application filed under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC, the petitioner has already filed a petition under Order 39 Rule 2-A of CPC for initiating contempt proceedings, which is stated to be pending adjudication.

No ground for interference is made out in the present petition especially when the party has already invoked civil remedy.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
