This petition has been filed for handing over investigation of case FIR No.343 dated 14.08.2016, under Sections 147, 149, 354 (a) (1), 380, 427, 506, registered at Police Station, Narnaund, to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 5, by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hansi, has been filed, wherein it has been stated that after registration of the aforesaid FIR, investigation has been carried out by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hansi. No incriminating evidence supporting the allegations levelled by the complainant came on the file. It was found that on 04.07.2016, house of the petitioners was found locked from outside and the household articles were found to be scattered and unorganized. There was no evidence on record to corroborate the allegations about taking away 10 *tolas* of gold and Rs.50,000/- in cash by the accused. No person came forward to strengthen

been written in this case by the Station House Officer, Police Station, Narnaund, which is under the process and the same shall be submitted before the Court in due course.

It has been further stated that petitioner No.1 also filed a criminal complaint under Section 354 (a) (b), 380, 427, 448, 452, 506, 166, 217, 218 read with Section 120-B IPC before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hansi relating to the same incident, wherein vide order dated 08.08.2016, the accused have been summoned to face trial under Sections 448, 452 and 506 IPC. Thereafter, on the statement made by Murti-respondent No.15, FIR No. 415 dated 24.09.2016, under Sections 323, 341, 447, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, has been registered against the present petitioners at Police Station Narnaund (Annexure R-1). In this case, the petitioners were arrested at the spot and final report has already been filed before the trial Court.

In view of the above reply filed by respondent Nos. 1 to 5, no further directions are required to be given in this case.

Disposed of accordingly.
