Petitioner-Navjot Singh alias Nannu has filed this 2nd petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of interim regular bail for three weeks in case FIR No.07 dated 17.01.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

It is mentioned in the petition that wife of the petitioner is suffering from Multinodular goiter with suspicious nodules in the bilateral thyroid lobes/carcinoma of Thyroid with compression symptoms to trachea and oesophagus and she needs to undergo a major surgery for her treatment. It is also mentioned that presence of the

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petitioner is required in the hospital for consent, post-operative care of his wife and for depositing expenses as there is nobody else at home to take care of her. The petitioner has two minor children and his elder son is also handicapped.

Notice of motion was issued. In pursuance of notice of motion, learned State counsel appeared and filed reply by way of short affidavit of Sh. Akashdeep Singh Aulakh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dhuri, which was taken on record. In short reply filed by the State, it is mentioned that treatment of wife of the petitioner is going on at Bhabha Cancer Hospital, Sangrur and the doctor has suggested for her operation. It is also mentioned in the reply that sons of the petitioners are minor and there is no other family member to look after her during the operation.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

In view of the fact that the wife of the petitioner is suffering from Multinodular goiter with suspicious nodules in the bilateral thyroid lobes/carcinoma of Thyroid with compression symptoms to trachea and oesophagus and she needs to undergo a major surgery for her treatment, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail w.e.f 13.11.2017 to 30.11.2017, subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹10 lakhs with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court

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on 30.11.2017 failing which the trial Court shall proceed further in
accordance with law.
