Petitioner-Sanjeev Sood has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.111 dated 20.06.2017, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, under Section 420 IPC, Sections 51, 63 and 68 of the Copyright Act, 1957 and Sections 465, 467 and 471 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that allegations against the petitioner are under Section 420 IPC and violation of provisions of the Copyright Act regarding some song etc.

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The petitioner has been in custody since 19.07.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
