Petitioner Sanjeev Sharma has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 09.02.2015 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kurukshetra, in a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and to set aside the order dated 20.08.2015 jointly passed in CRR-63-2015 and CRR-59-2015 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra under Section 397 CR.P.C. and all the consequent proceedings arisen therefrom.

Both the parties have amicably compromised their matrimonial dispute. They filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. Their statements in first motion and second motion had been recorded in terms of the compromise entered into between them. A decree of divorce by mutual consent was passed by us today.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent Jyoti Sharma on instructions from the respondent who is present today, submits that she has no objection for quashing the above proceedings.

In view of the above development in the matrimonial dispute that has arisen between the parties, we are pleased to quash the order dated 09.02.2015 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kurukshetra, in a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and to set aside the order dated 20.08.2015 jointly passed in CRR-63-2015 and CRR-59-2015 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra under Section 397 CR.P.C. and all the consequent proceedings arisen therefrom.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
