Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 for immediate and urgent protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from respondents No.5 to 7 who are trying to dispossess him from his self-owned house.

Vide order dated 17.04.2017, it was noticed that an application is pending before the District Magistrate, U.T., Chandigarh under Sections 21 and 22 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that vide order dated 20.07.2017, the said application has been allowed and the

private respondents No.5 to 7 have been directed to vacate house of the petitioner within 30 days from the date of issuance of the order. A photocopy of the order dated 20.07.2017 passed by District Magistrate, U.T., Chandigarh is placed on record. It is further submitted that respondents No.5 to 7 have now challenged the order dated 20.07.2017 before this Court by way of filing writ petition and the same is pending.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one, in case the petitioner still feel any eminent threat to his life and liberty.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, it will be open to the petitioner in case he feel any threat to his life and liberty, he can approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh who will immediately look after the grievance of the petitioner and do the needful.
