This is a petition under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 117 dated 27.6.2017 under Sections 21/61/85/27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, one Sukhjot Singh @ Sukhi was nabbed by the police and during personal search 5 gms smack was recovered. On the disclosure statement of Sukhjot Singh @ Sukhi, petitioner was found involved in the present FIR.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Om Parkash, further submits that petitioner is involved in two more FIRs i.e. FIR No. 222 dated 28.10.2015 and FIR No. 72 dated 14.7.2016 under Sections 21/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Jakhal and has opposed the concession of bail on the ground that petitioner is a habitual

Without commenting upon merits of the case and considering the fact that petitioner is involved in the aforesaid two FIRs of criminal nature, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out in the present petition.

Dismissed.
