INDERJIT SINGH, J.

This order shall dispose of CRM-M-31431-2017 and CRM-M-31434-2017, filed by petitioner -Harjinder Singh, under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in criminal complaint No.Comp/666/2016 dated 27.01.2016, titled as 'Sukhbir Singh Hooda vs. Harjinder Singh',

under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, pending in the Court of Sh. Parveen Kumar, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh.

Notice of motion was issued in both these petitions. Learned APP for U.T. Chandigarh appeared on behalf of respondent-U.T. Chandigarh and respondent No.2 also appeared through his counsel. They contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that as per the interim order dated 25.08.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner presented the draft of ₹2 lakh in both the cases, but the trial Court has asked him to bring two demand drafts of ₹2 lakh each, which was later on clarified by this Court. He argued that the trial Court has returned the draft.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I accept both these petitions and the petitioner is directed to deposit demand draft of ₹2 lakh as per the interim order already passed by this Court within 07 days from today. On doing so, the trial Court shall release him on bail to its satisfaction.
