On 01.02.2017, following order was passed by this

Court:

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner

contends that the complainant being a married

woman after having relation with the alleged

paramour/petitioner, now alleges cheating when the petitioner was engaged with someone else. Furthermore, despite the allegations of sexual assaults, no offence to that extent has been incorporated in the FIR.

Notice of motion for 17.04.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 16.02.2017 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head

Constable Ramesh Chand stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and challan has already been presented in the trial Court.

Mr. Ashok Kumar Sama, Advocate, for the complainant, however, opposed the application on the ground that there are allegations of sexual assault, but no offence was incorporated by the police in the FIR.

Keeping in view the fact that challan has already been presented, order dated 01.02.2017, is hereby made absolute.
