Status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Piara Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Tarn Taran on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

In the status report the State has taken the stand that the police has visited the house of the petitioners for questioning the petitioner No. 4 in a case pertaining to FIR No. 56 dated 10.08.2017 registered under Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Tarn Taran.
