Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.8 dated 09.01.2017 under Sections 382 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station City Balachaur, Distirct SBS Nagar.

Learend counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. More so, co-accused namely, Sukhwinder Singh has already been released on bail by learned trial Judge on 10.07.2017. The petitioner is in custody since 06.04.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time.

Learend State counsel on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, stated that there is no other case of similar nature against the petitioner. He further contended that allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature and he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 06.04.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, SBS Nagar.

The petition stands allowed.
