The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 13.07.2017 under Sections 307/323/34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case as he is son of Nachhatar Singh, who was injured in the occurrence after a sudden fight with the complainant and his father-Angrej Singh.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he was armed with revolver and fired three shots, out of which two hit the complainant on his thigh.

Taking into consideration that the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature, I do not find it a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the instant petition is dismissed.
