The present appeal was filed by complainant Munshi Ram for challenging the judgment dated 9.10.2002 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sirsa whereby the accused/respondent stood exonerated of the charge under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

When the appeal was taken up for final hearing on 7.2.2017, learned counsel for the respondent informed the Court that the complainant/appellant had passed away during the pendency of the appeal and, therefore, the appeal cannot
