ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.175 dated 28.11.2015, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that he has illegally got the khasra girdawari for the year 1997 to 2002 changed in his name. He further contends that petitioner was in possession of the land since 1994 and was duly entered as owner by the Central Government in the year 2010.

This Court, by the order dated 25.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and he was to be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sukhchain Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 25.08.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
