The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 97 dated 30.04.2016, under Section 304-B, 34 IPC, registered at P.S. City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 78 years old and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

Appearance has been put in by Mr. J.S. Thind, Advocate, on behalf of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the respondent-state as well as counsel for the complainant oppose the grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner herein while submitting that the deceased was only 30 years

old and died within three years of her marriage leaving behind minor child and there were several injuries on her body as well as three legature marks and that petitioner is not entitled to grant of concession of regular bail.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have perused the record of the case. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and keeping in view the age of the petitioner and that she is in custody since 12.05.2016; the statement of two material witnesses have been recorded and that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, this petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
