Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.274 dated 15.11.2016 under Sections 148, 149, 341 and 120-B IPC as well as Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sanjit Kumar, states that the petitioner is involved in as many as 9 cases and even during pendency of the present petition, FIR No.0285 dated 05.12.2017 under Sections 148, 149 and 302 IPC as well as Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 has been registered against him at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner as well as the fact that he is involved in a number of other cases, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
