Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.44 dated 29.04.2015 registered under Sections 306, 120-B and 506 IPC at Police Station Badhni Kalan, Moga, District Moga, Punjab.

It is submitted that petitioners were found innocent during investigation. They have been summoned on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. It is submitted that the petitioners have appeared before the learned trial Court on 10th October, 2017 pursuant to interim order dated 28.09.2017 passed by this Court. They undertake to face the proceedings before the learned trial Court and be present on each and every date fixed. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Pal Singh, verifies that petitioners have indeed appeared before the learned trial Court.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioners are likely to abscond or that they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, interim bail afforded to the petitioners be made absolute subject to their furnishing bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
