As per case of the petitioners, petitioner No.1 Anusuiya aged about 19 years, has got married with petitioner No.2 - Deepak Kumar aged about 37 years and a divorcee, against wishes of family members of petitioner No.1, arrayed as private respondents No. 4 to 9. Now the petitioners apprehend danger to their lives and liberty at the hands of such private respondents, as such they have approached this Court by way of filing present petition.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to look into the grievance

of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9 or persons claiming under them.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
