This is a petition under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioner in case FIR No. 61 dated 19.5.2017 under Sections 379-B and 323 IPC registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, six boys having muffled faces came to the petrol pump on their motor cycles and took away cash; two mobile phones; 9 litres Mobil oil and forcibly filled their motorcycles' tanks after giving beating to the complainant- Akhilesh Pandey. He further submits that as per the custody certificate filed in the Court on 31.8.2017, petitioner is already on regular bail in other cases and there is a delay of about 8 days in registration of the FIR.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, submits that as per the disclosure statement, petitioner has been involved in the

present case.

Keeping in view the above fact and without commenting upon the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found involved in any other subsequent case or found misusing concession of bail.
